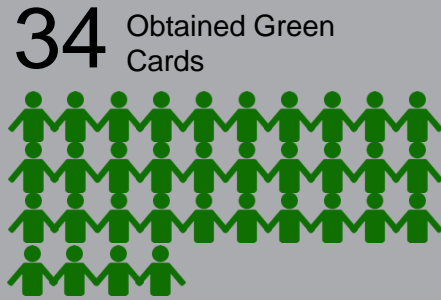

In 2016 MICA has reached hundreds in Missouri and Illinois with presentations about changes in immigration policy:

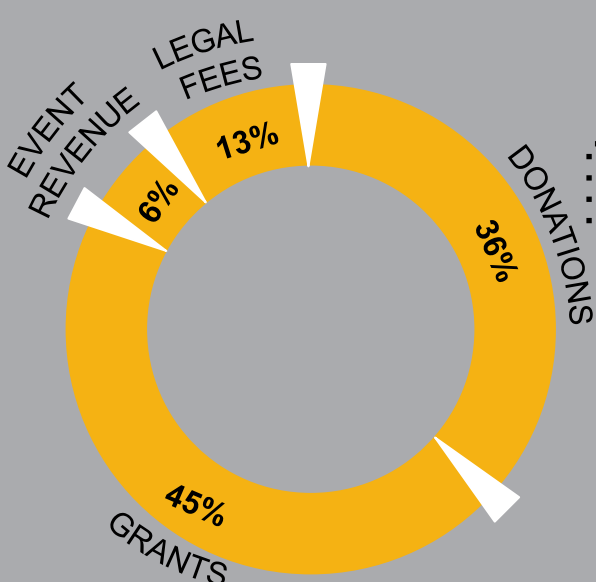
- Supreme Court decision U.S. v. Texas: **How does (DAPA) impact families?**
